PREREQUISITE: Cert as Dive Leader/equiv. or Basic EANx Diver and minimum 18 years of age.

This three day course trains participants to dive to a depth of 40m using Nitrox as a bottom mix. It covers the use of Nitrox as a decompression gas and provides theory and practice in decompression techniques.

OPEN WATER DIVES

- A CONFINED water must be conducted prior to OW dives.
- FOUR dives (two Nitrox and two which may be credited air dives if sufficient number of previous logged dives can be provided)
- At least ONE shallow water session
- TWO dives up to 40m with decompression
- Total bottom time 120mins

EXAMINATION - Written Test

EQUIPMENT

- Large EANx Cylinder (Pref. Dual take-off)
- 3ltr pony bottle
- 2 x Primary regulators (1 x 2m second stage hose)
- 1 x Decompression regulator (MUST be O2 serviced)
- Delayed surface marker buoy and reel
- All Necessary diving equipment suitable for locality
